Situation:

Ludwigsburg (pop. 93,000), built in the early 1700's in the region of Stuttgart, over 40% of the population from a migrant background.

AKI—"Aktion Integration" is an interdenominational group that works with refugees in Ludwigsburg, treating each refugee with dignity, seeing them as an enrichment for us personally and for our nation. They want to show the refugees that they are welcome in Germany and build bridges between them and the German people.

They have many regular programs such as German courses, women's groups, visiting, seekers meetings, children's programs, eating together, as well as special programs such as camps, once off evenings etc. There are currently two full time workers and many (up to 80 active per week) volunteers, many of whom are students. This means that there is constant change and is why a longer term worker would be valued. AKI works mostly with German churches in the area but also with a Persian church.
