Situation:

The former East Germany is officially one of the least religious places on the planet, with more than half of the people living there saying they do not believe in God. A study by social scientists at the University of Chicago showed that in the former East Germany, 12 percent of those over 68 said they believed in God, while not a single under-28-year-old said they did.

The International Missions Church of Erfurt is a community of believers in Jesus Christ who are joined together by a spiritual rebirth. The basis of their faith and everyday life is the Bible alone. Church services are in both English and German.

Mission statement: To be an open community that offers people the opportunity to know Jesus Christ and accompanies them in their lives.
